WEAPONS

As an aviation safety officer, you will be required to review your unit's standing operating procedure (SOP) concerning gunnery operations, to include training. Also, you may be required to act as an officer in charge (OIC) of an aerial gunnery range or to act as a range safety officer (RSO) To meet these requirements, you must have an understanding of the weapons used on Army aircraft. Of particular importance to a safety officer are those weapon characteristics that affect accuracy or present a hazard (noise, muzzle overpressure, or back blast) to unprotected personnel. For this purpose, weapons used on Army aircraft can be grouped into three categories: guns (7.62-mm machine guns and miniguns, 20-mm and 30-mm cannons, and 40-mm grenade launchers), rockets (2.75-inch folding fin aerial rockets (FFAR)), and missiles (tube-launched, optically tracked, wire-guided (TOW) antitank missiles and SS-11 antitank guided missiles)
